Background. ILBE will be a direct replacement for the Modular Lightweight Load Bearing Equipment (MOLLE) system.

- The ILBE Pack System consists of a 4500 cu in. Main Ruck, 1500 cu in. Assault Pack, and a 100oz. Hydration System, produced by Source Vagabond.
- The ILBE a modified commercial Arc'teryx Bora 95 Pack.
- Assault Load Carrier (ALC) component is being evaluated as a replacement of MOLLE Fighting Load Carrier in early FY05.
- Other ILBE systems include: RECON ILBE (R-ILBE), Corpsman Assault Pack (CAP), and ALC Pouch System
